# #5 Virginia Tech (22-11) vs. #4 Southern Illinois (28-6)

#### **Entering Today's Game**

The Hokies enter today's game 22-11 overall and finished the regular season 10-6 in ACC play ... The Hokies are the fifth seed in the 2007 NCAA West Region ... Southern Illinois is 28-6 overall ... SIU is the fourth seed in the tournament.

#### Last Time Out, #5 Virginia Tech 54, #12 Illinois 52

The Hokies put on one of their best comebacks in memory and came back from a 13-point deficit with 8:18 remaining and defeated Illinois, 54-52, in the first round of the NCAA West Region in Columbus, Ohio, on Friday night ... Tech scored the final 12 points of the contest, holding the Illini without a basket for the last 4:27 of action ... **Deron Washington** banked in a jumper in the lane with 46 seconds remaining to give the Hokies a 53-52 lead and **A.D. Vassallo** hit a free throw in the final 23 seconds to give the Hokies a 54-52 lead ... Illinois had a couple of late chances, but the Hokies held on for the win ... Washington led the Hokies with 14 points and **Coleman Collins** added 13 points in the win ... **Jamon Gordon** scored 10 points and had seven assists and seven steals in the win.

#### Taking Care of the Ball

In the quarterfinal win over Wake Forest, the Hokies committed just two turnovers, both coming in the first half ... That is a season-low for the Hokies and the second-lowest in ACC Tournament history ... The only time a team has committed fewer turnovers in an ACC Tournament game came in 1968, when NC State committed just one turnover in a 12-10 quarterfinal win over Duke.

#### The Series Vs. SIU

A rematch of a game in the Old Spice Classic in November, this is just the second meeting between the Hokies and the Salukis ... SIU won the first meeting, 69-64 on Nov. 26 at the Milk House in Orlando.

#### The First

Virginia Tech's 54-52 win over Illinois in the first round game on Friday night is the first NCAA win for the Hokies under **Seth Greenberg** (it was the team's first NCAA game under Greenberg) ... This was the Hokies' first NCAA appearance since the 1996 tournament ... It is the Hokies' first NCAA Tournament win since a 61-48 win over Wisconsin-Green Bay in the first round of the 1996 NCAA Midwest Region in Dallas, Texas.

#### Noting the Win over Illinois

The 54 points the Hokies' scored in the win over Illinois is the fewest for the Hokies in an NCAA victory and the second fewest points scored by Tech in any NCAA Tournament game ... Tech got no points off the bench in the game, just four rebounds ... The 21 points scored by Tech in the first half was tied for the fewest points scored by Tech in a half this season and the fewest points scored in a half this season and the fewest points scored in a half this season in a game the Hokies won ... Tech's 11 steals is the most this season by an Illinois opponent ... Illinois' 52 points is the fewest by a Tech opponent since Tech allowed UNC Greensboro 51 points on Jan. 10 and the fourth-lowest of the season ... Tech was outrebounded, 37-22.

#### Tech in the NCAA Tournament

Virginia Tech is now 6-7 all-time in the NCAA Tournament ... The Hokies are now 5-3 in first round games ... **Seth Greenberg** is the fifth head coach to lead the Hokies into the NCAA Tournament ,,, All five have won at least one game.

#### **Increasing on Good**

With his seven steals in the win over Illinois, **Jamon Gordon** now has 93 steals for the season, setting a new Virginia Tech record for steals in a season ... The old record was Dell Curry's 89 steals in the 1983-84 season ... Gordon now has three of the top ten single-season steals totals at Virginia Tech, the only Hokie to hold that distinction ... Gordon's 153 assists this season are third-best in school history and surpass his best-ever season of 133 assists last season ... **Zabian Dowdell** has 70 steals this season, tying his career-high

... The 70 steals are sixth-best in school history.

#### Making a Comeback

Virginia Tech came back from a 13point, second half deficit in the win over Illinois, the largest deficit overcome in a game this season ... In Virginia Tech's 65-53 win over Richmond, the Hokies came back from a 12-point, first half deficit, ... Tech overcame a 12-point deficit three times last season ... The largest deficit the Hokies have overcome in an ACC game is 13 points, against N.C. State in Blacksburg in the 2004-05 season ... The largest deficit the Hokies have overcome under **Seth Greenberg** was 15 points at home against Rutgers in the 2003-04 season.

#### A Different Kind of Effective

**Deron Washington** is the Hokies' second-leading scorer and usually gets his points in transition ... In the win over Illinois, Washington found another way to get his points ... Washington was a perfect three-for-three from three-point range, setting a new career-high in three-pointers made ... Washington entered the season with a total of 10 career three-pointers and has 19 threes this season.

#### More on Deron

**Deron Washington** is just 66 points shy of 1,000 points for his career ... With his two blocked shots in the win over Illinois, Washington is now 11th in career blocked shots and needs just nine blocks to reach 100 career blocked shots.

#### Closing in on a Record

Jamon Gordon recorded seven steals in the win over Illinois and with it, raised his career total to 289 career steals

... Former NBA great Dell Curry is the Hokies' all-time leader, with 295.

#### Gimme That!

Virginia Tech recorded 11 steals in the win over Illinois ... That is the 11th time this season that the Hokies have recorded at least 10 steals in a game ... The 11 steals is tied for the fifth-highest total of the season for the Hokies ... Tech had 16 steals in the win over Seton Hall in Madison Square Garden ... In that game, **Jamon Gordon** had a season-high seven steals, a number he tied in the win over Wake Forest in the ACC Tournament and again on Friday night in the win over Illinois.

#### Tops in the League

Jamon Gordon was named the 2007 ACC Defensive Player of the Year, in a vote by members of the Atlantic Coast Sports Media Association ... Gordon, a senior from Jacksonville, Fla., received 54 first place votes, outdistancing teammate Zabian Dowdell and Maryland's D.J. Strawberry, who had 12 votes each ... Gordon and Dowdell were each named to the ACC All-Defensive team ... This is the first time a Virginia Tech player has won one of the league's top individual awards ... Gordon was also the top vote getter in the poll of league coaches by *The Fan's Guide's* annual poll.

#### **Dowdell All-District**

Zabian Dowdell was selected first team Division I District Four All-District for 2007, as selected by members of the National Association of Basketball Coaches ... Dowdell was one of eight ACC players named to various first team All-District teams ... A total of 11 ACC players are listed on the various first and second teams nationally.

#### Fun Facts on Foes

Virginia Tech will face Southern Illinois in the second round on Sunday ... This is the Hokies' second meeting with SIU this season and the Hokies' second straight game against a team from Illinois ... Entering this season, Tech had only played a total of eight games against schools from Illinois ... Tech is now 5-5 all-time against teams from Illinois ... Tech is now 14-10 alltime against Big Ten schools and 2-0 this season ... Tech is 2-1 against Big Ten foes in NCAA Tournament games.

#### Lotsa Games

Today is the Hokies' 34th game of the season ... The school record for most games in a season is 35, achieved twice before (1983-84 and 1994-95) ... Tech's 22 victories entering today's game is tied for the fourth-most in school history ... Tech won a school-record 25 games in the 1995-96 season.

#### **Close Games**

With the win over Illinois, the Hokies are 20-20 under **Seth Greenberg** in games that were decided in overtime or by five-or-fewer points, including a 6-5 record in such games this season ... Three conference wins came in overtime against nationally-ranked teams ... Tech was 2-10 in such games last season, with 10 games being decided in the final seconds of action of those games ... Tech was 5-3 in such games during the 2004-05 season after finishing 7-2 the previous year.

#### Mr. 500

With his five assists in the ACC quarterfinal win over Wake Forest, **Jamon Gordon** became just the second man in Virginia Tech history to record 500 assists in a career ... Bimbo Coles is the all-time leader, with 547 and Gordon now has 513 assists.

#### **Hokies on a Neutral Floor**

The Hokies are no strangers to playing on a neutral court this season ... Tech is 5-4 this season on a neutral floor ... Tech was 1-2 in the Old Spice Classic in Orlando over Thanksgiving (including a loss to Southern Illinois) ... Tech is 7-10 on a neutral floor under Seth Greenberg ... The Hokies were 1-1 in the ACC Tournament in Tampa last week ... Tech is 5-7 in the NCAA Tournament on a neutral court.

#### Dowdell, Gordon Earn ACC Honors

Two Virginia Tech Hokies earned All-ACC honors this season ... Zabian Dowdell has been named to the All-ACC first team, as selected by members of the Atlantic Coast Sports Media Association ... Teammate Jamon Gordon has been named to the third team All-ACC ... Dowdell was an honorable mention All-ACC in each of the Hokies' first two seasons in the league and this is Gordon's first time on any All-ACC team ... This is the first time that a Hokie has been named first team All-ACC ... The last time a Hokie was named to an all-conference first team was the 2003-04 season, when Bryant Matthews was named first team All-BIG EAST in the Hokies' final season in the league ... Both Dowdell and Gordon have also been named to the All-ACC Defensive team ... This is the second consecutive season that both Dowdell and Gordon have been named to the All-Defensive team ... Gordon and Dowdell led the ACC in steals this season ... The individual awards for the ACC were announced on Tuesday, March 6.

#### **Seeing the Hokies**

The crowd of 22,269 announced for the Hokies' quarterfinal win over Wake Forest and the loss the next day to NC State is tied for the fourth-largest crowds ever to see a Virginia Tech men's basketball game

... A crowd of 21,750 watched the Hokies defeat #4 North Carolina in the Smith Center on Feb. 13, 2007 ... It was, at the time, the fifth-largest crowd ever to witness a Virginia Tech men's basketball game ... The attendance at the Jan. 31, 2004 game in the Carrier Dome against Syracuse was 25,862, the largest crowd ever to see the Hokies play a basketball game ... The previous record was 23,226 at the Carrier Dome on Jan. 26, 2002 ... Below are the top five attendances for a Virginia Tech men's basketball game.

#### Into the 10

With his 17 points in the loss at #25 Virginia, **Zabian Dowdell** passed Ace Custis into seventh place in career scoring at Virginia Tech ... He currently has 1,778 points ... He needs five points to pass Bob Ayersman into sixth place and 27 points to pass Allan Bristow into fifth place in career scoring at Tech ... Bimbo Coles is the alltime scoring leader at Virginia Tech with 2,484 career points.

#### **Senior Addition**

This season, Virginia Tech's five-man senior class of **Zabian Dowdell**, **Jamon Gordon**, **Coleman Collins**, **Markus Sailes** and **Chris Tucker** have combined for 1,300 points ... That constitutes 54.6 percent of the Virginia Tech point total this season ... In ACC action, that fivesome combined for 619 points, or 57.4 percent of the team's total.

#### Two of a Kind

Virginia Tech's tandem of small forwards, **Deron Washington** and **A.D. Vassallo**, are having very productive seasons for the Hokies ... The duo combines to average 23.2 points and 9.3 rebounds per game ... In the win over Wake Forest in the quarterfinals of the ACC Tournament, the duo combined for 35 points, eight rebounds and shot a combined 13-26 from the floor ... In ACC games, they averaged 23.0 points per game and 9.6 rebounds.

#### Lights, Camera, Hokies

Virginia Tech is 16-10 on television this season ... During the 2005-06 season, the Hokies made 18 television appearances ... The previous year, the Hokies made 17 regular season television appearances and three more in the post-season ... Tech was 6-12 on television in the 2005-06 season ... Tech is 35-43 on television under Seth Greenberg ... The Hokies will make at least a record 16 national television appearances this season ... Tech made eight national television appearances during the 2005-06 regular season, up from four the previous year ... Beginning with the game at ODU and ending with the win over Georgia Tech, the Hokies played nine consecutive televised games last season ... All remaining Virginia Tech regular season games will be televised ... This tournament marks the Hokies' first appearance on CBS since the 1995-96 NCAA Tournament.

#### The Only One

Jamon Gordon is the only active NCAA Division I player to record 1,200 career points, 500 career rebounds, 500 career assists and 250 career steals.

#### **The Good Hands People**

When the guartet of Virginia Tech guards (Zabian Dowdell, Jamon Gordon, Nigel Munson and Markus Sailes) have the ball, its usually in pretty good hands ... As a group, the Tech guards have 329 assists and just 178 turnovers ... In the win over Iowa, the Hokies, as a team, committed only eight turnovers, including just two in the first half ... In the win over ODU, Tech's starting backcourt of Gordon and Dowdell had 11 assists and just two turnovers ... Tech committed just five turnovers in the win over Richmond and just seven in the win at #5 Duke ... In the quarterfinal win over Wake Forest, the quartet combined for 13 assists and just one turnover ... Sailes has just 13 turnovers in 31 games this season and had just five in 15 ACC games this season.

#### **Nationally Known**

Virginia Tech is well-represented in the current list of NCAA Division I leaders, as of March 11 ... **Zabian Dowdell** is ranked 35th in steals per game and 66th in points per game ... **Jamon Gordon** is ranked ninth nationally in steals per game and 86th in assists per game ... As a team, the Hokies are sixth nationally in fewest turnovers per game, 30th in steals per game, 39th in scoring margin and 41st in field goal percentage.

#### Seth Numbers

Seth Greenberg won his 250th game as a collegiate head coach in the Hokies' 94-66 win over North Carolina A&T on Dec. 7, 2005 ... Greenberg has a career record of 280-225 (.554) in 17 seasons as a collegiate head coach and he is 67-55 (.554) in three-plus seasons at Virginia Tech.

#### On Our Side

Virginia Tech is now 1-1 all-time in Nationwide Arena ... The Hokies lost to Ohio State, 62-57, in this arena three seasons ago ... Tech fell to Ohio State in Value City Arena last season ... The Hokies are now 3-2 all-time in Columbus.

#### The 500 Point Club

Zabian Dowdell scored his 500th point of the season in the home win over Miami ... It is the first time a Hokie has scored 500-or-more points in a season since Bryant Matthews scored 641 points in the 2003-04 season ... Dowdell needs 55 points to reach the top 10 in single-season points scored at Virginia Tech.
