

STAFF INFORMATION

Scot Thomas Head Coach - 18th year

Now entering his 18th season, Coach Scot Thomas has positioned Hokie softball as one of the most respected programs, not only in the conference and region, but on the national map as well. Since taking the job in 1995, he has recorded over 600 wins and has averaged nearly 36 wins per season, including ACC titles and region coaching staff of the year honors in both 2007 or 2008.




In 2008, he took the Hokies to the Women's College World Series and also led his team to a historic upset of the U.S. National Team, breaking the Red, White & Blue's 185-game pre-Olympic exhibition tour winning streak with a 1-0 win. This is the same program that had won the previous three Olympic gold medals in the sport and took silver in Beijing.

While success on the field is important, Thomas also places a strong emphasis on success in the classroom. In 17 seasons, he has had several players earn Academic All-America honors, including Angela Tincher who was named the Academic All-American of the Year in 2008. She was also named the National Player of the Year, earning the rare

Thomas graduated from East Tennessee State University in 1991 with a bachelor's in physical education. A native of Blacksburg, Va., Thomas graduated from Blacksburg High where he was a member of the football and baseball teams.

Al Brauns Associate Head Coach - 15th year





A favorite among current and past players, Brauns also is in charge of field maintenance, travel, equipment and has a heavy hand in recruiting. The Scot Thomas Softball Camp at Virginia Tech, which have seen a huge spike in attendance over the past few years, is also run by the long-time assistant coach. Brauns started playing fastpitch in the 1960s and finished his career playing with a men's major team from 1970-74. He is originally from Uniontown, Pa., and graduated from Penn State in 1973 with a degree in criminology.

Barb Sherwood Assistant Coach - 5th year

Assistant coach Barb Sherwood is in her fifth year with the Hokie coaching staff as the pitching coach. Sherwood has also spent time at Florida State University, the University of Wisconsin and Troy University.

A four-year letterwinning catcher and team captain at Troy, Sherwood earned her bachelor's of science degree in physical education in 1999 and followed-up with a Master's in education in 2000.

Sherwood remains the winningest player in Troy softball history. The Trojans won 176 games while Sherwood was on the roster from 1995 to 1998. She was a three-time team captain and helped lead the Trojans to the 1996 Mid-Continent Conference championship and a berth in the 1996 NCAA Tournament.

Camp Staff will consist of the Virginia Tech coaching staff as well as other collegiate and high school coaches. Current and former Virginia Tech players will also be assisting.

GENERAL INFORMATION

It is the aim of the Scot Thomas Softball Camp at Virginia Tech to provide athletes with the best instruction and atmosphere in which to improve upon softball fundamentals and sharpen skills.

Camp includes instruction on fielding, hitting, throwing, base running, pitching, catching and situational play. Camp is open to any and all participants in the fifth grade through newly graduated seniors.
